## Summary of Findings

Administration of access and log on to the Maytas System is managed by Health Education England, the project lead for HEE is responsible for administrating secure login- ins and they will also have access to the system. The Maytas system will replace a system that is no longer fit for purpose. The Maytas system will be used by the learning and development team to process learner's information to request funding from Health Education and Skills funding Agency. The system will store personal and special categories data, an Individual learning paper record is completed and signed for by the learner, which details the use of the information that will be processed in the system

HEE have a 3<sup>rd</sup> party contract agreement with Tribal Itd who host the Maytas software a review of this contract has been completed and the contract is GDPR compliant this gives assurance to the Trust that there are security measures in place to protect learners information stored in the system.

#### **Risks Identified**
