What is the purpose of the panel?

The panel is made up of representatives from local communities and interest groups.

Members are consulted on, and co-produce, improvements of our ambulance, patient transport and 111 services respectively.

- Be respectful of other members' views and personal experiences, fostering a culture of inclusivity

- Regular communication Updates on recently completed PPP involvement projects, as well as on-going and any upcoming PPP involvement opportunities.

- Development Sharing of various training and development opportunities to grow as a panel member
