

## Diagnosis and clinical observations

Can we assess you now?



Do you have any allergies?

We would like to count your breathing rate by listening to your chest.





We would like to check your pulse and oxygen level with this clip that goes on your finger.

It does not hurt.



# We would like to check your blood pressure with this cuff.



We would like to check your temperature by putting this in your ear.



We would like to check your blood sugar levels by taking a drop of blood from your finger.



You will feel a little scratch.

We need to do a few more checks to find out more.



We would like to shine a small torch into your eyes.





We would like to have a feel and listen of your stomach.



We would like to look at your heart with this monitor.



It has some stickers and wires that we need to put on you.

#### Trauma care

We can see you have injuries.

- We will stop any bleeding.
- We will dress and bandage any wounds.




# We will need to support your arm / leg with a splint.



We will need to protect your neck and back.

We will use equipment that keeps you lying down still.

It might feel strange but you will be completely safe.



## Intervention and treatment

We would like to give you medicine to help you.



Do you have any allergies to medicines?

We would like to give you some oxygen to help with your breathing.



We may need to give you some other medication through the mask.

We will need to give you the medication into your body using a needle and cannula.

It will mean a little sharp scratch.



#### Care and pathway

Can we take you to hospital in our ambulance?



You can bring someone with you if you like.

We will talk you through it and you will be completely safe.

### Can we bring some things you might need:

Medicine



Overnight bag



Keys



Money



Phone



Phone charger



Anything else you need?

Don't worry if you can't walk.

We will get you to the ambulance safely using a wheelchair or stretcher.



## We can offer you alternative transport if appropriate.





When was the last time you saw a doctor?



You may be eligible or due for an annual health check.

This would help to make sure things are not missed and you don't get too unwell in the future.

I can discuss this with your doctor if that's ok?

## You might not need to go to hospital

I will speak on the phone with a doctor or someone who knows a little more about your condition to get some advice.



# You seem better now and everything seems ok



I will tell the right people you may need extra support before I go.

Would you like me to do that?



You need to come to hospital with us so you can get the help you need.



We understand you have the right to make your own decision. Is there anything we can do to change your mind?


We can try and help with this.

## If you need help in the future.


